

TRAINEESHIPS STEP BY STEP GUIDE

- 1. You will either be referred to us by the job centre or apply for this Traineeship programme via our email address traineeships.enquiries@weston.ac.uk
- 2. Your first step with the College, is to attend an initial interview with our Recruitment Advisor. They will carry out an in-depth Information, Advice and Guidance (IAG) session to determine the best route for you to become workplace ready.
- **3.** The first **three** weeks of the Traineeship course involves employability training and work preparation. You will review the ID skills to set targets to support your progression and to gain the skills, knowledge and behaviours you need to make your next step.

You'll study topics such as:

- Motivation, mindset and target setting
- Team building and expectations of a workplace

- · Rights and responsibilities
- Awareness of equality and diversity
- PREVENT and safeguarding
- Professional applications: CV writing, cover letters, interview preparation.
- **4.** During your course, you will also study functional skills or GCSE English and maths, depending on your prior achievements.
- 5. From week four of your Traineeship, you will start your work placement and be supported within the workplace by an Assessor to train, develop and progress.
- You will come back into college one day per week for tutorials, English and maths during your work placement block.
